Teacher's Note:

You have the basics of Inktense and it's time to expand that knowledge! You will create this wonderful birch tree piece using techniques you learned in Beginning Inktense and expanding to the use of water, Inktense blocks and more! There is no stitching to start you out, so let the flow of ink guide you! Your kit will include the pattern and original artwork. Now you get to create it how you want it!

Supply List:

- 1. Fat Quarter of PFD (prepared for dyeing) fabric or more! You can never have enough!
- 2. Batting
- 3. A small set of Inktense Blocks or you can also buy the Inktense Paint Pan Travel Set
- 4. Inktense Pencils 12 or 24 Set
- 5. Paint Brushes You should already have brushes from Beginning Inktense, but feel free to bring what you want. I use 3 chisel brushes from Simply Simmons: 3/8", 1/2", and 1/4". You can get them on Amazon or Blick Art
- 6. Spray Bottle
- 7. Bottle to squirt water into an artist palette dish
- 8. Artist Palette Dish
- 9. Paper Towels
- 10. Craft exacto knife or other small knife to shave the sticks with
- 11. Small Pencil Sharpener
- 12. Pencil
- 13. Old Toothbrush



- 14. Textile Medium you used it in Beginning Inktense. My favorite is Ceramacoat Delta Creative Textile Medium. It's hard to find but Amazon may have it. My backup is Josonja Textile Medium. You can get that on Amazon as well.
- 15. Sturdy cup to hold water I use glass because it's heavy and I won't spill it.
- 16. Small 2 oz cup to hold your medium. Next time you are at a fast-food place grab one with the lid! I will bring some just in case!
- 17. Hair Dryer

Cancellation and Refund Policy
