## **Tucker University: Corner Pop**

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Stop throwing away half of those squares you used to pop off a corner and start saving your fabric by using the Corner Pop<sup>®</sup>. Before you know it, you will be popping off the corners of every unit. The Corner Pop<sup>®</sup> does just that — it helps to add a pop of color to any unit and can add a secondary pattern to your quilt.

Required tool: Corner Pop®

Required Design Sheet: Corner Pop

## **Required Tools:**

- Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
- **♣** Small cutting mat
- ♣ Straight edge ruler approx. 6" x 12" or so
- **♣** Thread
- **4** needles
- Snips or trimming scissors
- Seam ripper
- ♣ Invisgrip (Optional)
- ♣ Best Press or light starch (Optional)

**Remember!** Also bring your basic sewing supplies, such as your sewing machine (with power cord, foot pedal, and owner's manual), presser feet, bobbins, sewing machine needles, hand-sewing needles, fabric scissors, seam ripper, pin cushion, etc.

## **Fabric Requirements**

- \* NOTE: If you have taken previous Tucker University courses, you may already have some smaller scraps that measure at least 3-1/4" square. If this is the case, you are ready for class!
- ♣ Otherwise, you will need approximately (2) strips of fabric that measure no less than

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3- 1/4". For best results, these strips should read as a solid and be in strong contrast to your pre-class units as specified below.

## **Pre-class construction of units:**

- (4) 4-1/2" squares of fabric
- (4) 4-1/2" (cut-size) half square triangles\*
- Units of your choice that have a cut size of 4-1/2" or, in the case of a flying goose, the cut size would be 4-1/2" x 2-1/2. (For example, you might elect to construct (4) 4-1/2" quarter square triangle\* units, or (4) 4-1/2" V Blocks\* units, or (4) 4-1/2" Comer Beam\* units.)
